The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.202 dated 17.05.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 377 and 34 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar District Kurukshetra.

As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, petitioner failed to put in appearance and hence, the proceedings could not take place before the said Forum.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Richpal submits that in compliance of order dated 20.06.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She, on further instructions states that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

Heard learned counsel and perused the paper book.

Essentially, FIR in question was registered against the petitioner on account of a marital discord between the parties. Though earnest efforts were made before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of

this Court for an amicable settlement between the parties, however, it proved to be a futile exercise.

In the wake of the petitioner having joining the investigation and not being required for further investigation, the instant petition is allowed and interim order dated 20.06.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
