The petitioner herein has approached this Court for grant of additional marks on account of having the postgraduate/master degree as issued by the Indian Institute of Technology, Ropar, for appointment to the post of Male Constable, advertised vide advertisement No.4/2020, dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-7).

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner herein would submit that having applied for the post of Male Constable (General Duty) under the EWS category, he would come into the zone of consideration if the Haryana State Selection Commission would take into account his degree. It is submitted that his mark sheet is dated 13.08.2020 which is before the cut off date of 10.02.2021. He would rely upon orders passed in CWP No.3841 of 2019, titled as *Rahul Kumar Versus State of Haryana and another*, decided on 21.02.2019, wherein in similar circumstances, the Court had

directed the Commission to consider the case of the petitioner in case the result had been announced before the cut off date and he was not able to upload his detail marks-sheet.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that a decision has been taken in these cases that in case the result of the candidate before the cut off date has been announced and he has not uploaded his documents on the ground that he was not having the DMC of his qualification, then the Commission will consider the DMC at the time of giving marks for his qualification.

In view of the above factual position, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the result of the petitioner has been announced before the cut off date i.e. 10.02.2021, the Commission shall give him marks for his postgraduate/master degree, as per the criteria laid down in the advertisement dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-7), for the post of Male Constable.
