The petitioners herein seek the quashing of the FIR bearing No.0330 dated 12.12.2020 registered at Police Station Division No.8, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (wherein the offence under Section 201 IPC is stated to have been added later-on) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1-State in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to this respondent in advance and on the instructions from SI Surender Singh from the afore-said Police Station, he apprises the Court that after the return of the cancellation report by the Competent Court below to the investigating agency with a direction to conduct further investigation in the said case, the investigation is still continuing and has not yet been concluded.

3. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there need be, the petitioners would file the fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as claimed in this petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
