The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.37 dated 06.02.2022 under Sections 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated July 27, 2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation. He further admits that in the other FIRs registered against the petitioner, he has already been granted the concession of bail.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated July 27, 2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
