Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner competed in pursuance to advertisement No.3/2015 dated 28.06.2015 for appointment to the post of TGT advertised in various subjects. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner appeared for appointment to the post of TGT (Physical Education) and though, he appeared in the examination and secured 70 marks but, has declared ineligible by the respondents on the ground that the petitioner has not passed HTET (Test). Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that later on the condition of passing of the said test has been waived off by the respondents and as the post, against which, the petitioner competed is still lying vacant, respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment to the said post.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing

a representation dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P/24) upon them, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P/24) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P/24) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
