Mr. Balbir Singh Sewak, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.14 dated 15.03.2022, registered for offences under Sections 363 and 366-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short "IPC"), however, later on Section 376, IPC and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 were added, at Police Station Kabirpur, District Kapurthala, Annexure P-1.

Despite being apprised at the outset that the prosecutrix has not been examined, counsel for the petitioner insisted and argued the matter. Realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with his submissions, counsel for the petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
