The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.26 dated 14.03.2019 under Sections 420/120-B/506 IPC registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has nothing to do with the transaction related to the plot measuring 81 sq.yards situated at village Chuharwal, Tehsil & District Ludhiana, along with co-accused Vinay Mohan and Goldy Mohan. The sale deed has been executed and mutation entries stand done in favour of the complainant. It is also averred that quashing petition on the basis of compromise entered into the parties, has also been preferred by the other co-accused, which is pending before this Court on 18.01.2023, for recording of statement of the parties before the Illaqa Magistrate/CJM.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG Punjab accepts notice and does not controvert the above factual submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

Looking at the totality of facts and circumstances and in view of the fact that the conclusion of the trial is likely to take long time and, therefore, no fruitful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars and the fact that compromise has been entered between the parties, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition is, therefore, allowed.
