[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 21.04.2022, in CWP No.24595 of 2021 in case titled as '**SI Gharsa Ram versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.24595 of 2021 was disposed of in the light of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent(s) that order on representation dated 14.03.2021 would be passed within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order in case the same had already not been decided.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, has filed affidavit dated 15.09.2022 on behalf of the respondent along with order (Annexure R-1) dated 12.09.2022, as per which, the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 14.03.2021 has been rejected being devoid of any

merits. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is stated to have already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in view of order (Annexure R-1), she does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 12.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 12.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
