The present petition has been filed challenging the oral rejection of the prayer of the petitioners for the grant of regular permits under the Stage Carriage Scheme, 2016.

After notice of motion, respondents have filed reply and in para-3 of the reply following averments have been made:-

“That in view of the instructions dated 12.01.2021, Annexure R-1, case of the petitioners have been reconsidered and vide memo No.231 dated 08.02.2021 the petitioner no.1 Rajesh Kumar, vide memo No.232 dated 08.02.2021, petitioner no.2 Pardeep Kumar, vide memo No.226 dated 08.02.2021, petitioner no.3 Mandeep, vide memo No.235 dated 08.02.2021, petitioner no.4 Dinesh vide memo No.334 dated 24.02.2021, petitioner no.5 Anup Singh have been issued offer of allotment/LOI for the grant of temporary stage carriage permit. True copy of the letters dated 08.02.2021 and 24.02.2021 are being annexed as Annexure R-2 (colly) for kind perusal of

this Hon'ble Court. It is further submitted that further action in the matter shall be taken as per law and instructions and fulfilling of required terms and conditions of the LOI by the petitioners. Since the petitioners have been issued offer of allotment/LOI for the grant of temporary state carriage permit then the preset petition is liable to be dismissed, being infructuous.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the fact that respondents have already issued letter of intent to the petitioners, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
