This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for adding
Section 326 IPC in the headnote as well as prayer clause.

Notice of application.

Mr. Manipal Singh Atwal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in
Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection
if the application is allowed and Section 326 IPC, inadvertently not included
in the prayer clause of the main petition be added.

Application is allowed as prayed for.

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Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.79, dated
24.05.2022, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506, 379, 148 and 149 IPC,
registered at Police Station City, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

CRM-M-31632-2022 :2:

This Court vide order dated 26.07.2022 directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer subject to the conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The petitioners were directed to join investigation and co-operate with the Investigating Agency as and when required.

Today, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation, pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 26.07.2022.

Learned State counsel, on instructions states that the petitioners in fact has joined the investigation and not required any more for custodial interrogation at this stage.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that in case the Investigating Agency requires the petitioners to appear, they shall make themselves available without any demur.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioners is allowed and the order dated 26.07.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
