HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the daily wage service of the petitioner from 14.09.1981 to 01.10.1992 has not been taken into account for computing the pensionary benefits, which action of the respondents is arbitrary in nature and contrary to the rules governing the services as well as settled principles of law, hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to count the daily wage service of the petitioner rendered w.e.f.14.09.1981 to 01.10.1992 as a qualifying service so as to recompute the pensionary benefits and extend all the consequential benefits along with interest to the petitioner.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance by serving upon the respondents a legal notice dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-1), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage if the respondents are directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vivek Saini, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to deciding the legal notice dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
