The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.51, dated 14.05.2022 under Sections 395, 323, 341, 506, 363, 342 & 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

This Court on 21.07.2022 had issued notice of motion and granted interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining and co-operating with the investigation process.

On 12.09.2022, it was informed by the learned counsel for the parties that the petitioner could not join the investigation and the last opportunity was granted to him.

Today again, learned counsel for the parties have stated that the

petitioner has still not joined the investigation.

In view of the aforesaid position, since the petitioner has not complied with the orders passed by this Court and he has not joined the investigation despite the interim bail granted to him, therefore, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
