AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 13 dated 20.5.2021 under Sections 21 and 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at P.S. State Special Operations Cell, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

After arguing for some time and realizing that the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender and his contentions are not finding favour, in order to avoid adverse order, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Before parting, it would be not out of place to mention that in spite of secret information, the seriousness of the information and that the checking was conducted by Special Operation Team yet as per the story set up, the accused were able to flee the spot, if deem appropriate the issue needs to be looked into by the higher officials.
