These four appeals are listed for the preliminary hearing. The prayer is to modify the award passed by the Reference Court (hereinafter referred to as 'the RC') while deciding as many as 65 reference petitions including the reference petitions filed by the appellants in these four appeals.

The learned counsel representing the appellants submit that in view of the judgment passed in **Regular First Appeal No.2179 of 2021, titled as "Union of India Vs. Sunita and others", decided on 09.02.2022**, as many as 101 appeals were remanded back to the reference Court for deciding the matter afresh.

It has been pointed out that the award passed by the RC is the same as was in the aforesaid case.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the award passed by the RC is set aside. The matter is remanded back to the RC for deciding afresh in terms of the judgment passed in **Union of India's' case (supra)**.

Since this order has been passed without issuing notice to the Union of India, therefore the Union of India will have liberty to file an application for recall, if so advised.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the RC on 27.09.2022.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
