This is the petitioner's second attempt to get bail during the pendency of criminal case arising from FIR No.448, dated 20.11.2020, registered under Section 379-A and 34 of IPC (Section 420 IPC added later on), at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner along with two other boys snatched Rs.8,000/- from the first informant when he was replacing the punctured tyre of his vehicle on the highway. As per the status report filed by the State of Haryana, the petitioner is involved in eight other criminal cases involving heinous offences.

d.	<i>FIR No.258 dated 23.08.2020 under Section 379A, 341, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Bawal, District Rewari (Haryana). In that case, petitioner is facing trial and petitioner is on bail.</i>
e.	<i>FIR No.520 of 2020 under Section 379, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Vilaspur, Gurugram (Haryana). In that case, petitioner is facing trial and petitioner is on bail.</i>
f.	<i>FIR No.514 dated 15.12.2019 under Section 392, 397, 34 IPC and registered at Police Station Khedki Daula, Gurugram (Haryana). In that case, petitioner is facing trial and petitioner is not on bail.</i>
g.	<i>FIR No.311 dated 24.12.2020 under Section 392, 34 IPC and Section 25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Manesar, Gurugram (Haryana). In that case, petitioner is facing trial and petitioner is on bail.</i>
h.	<i>FIR No.471 of 2020 under Section 323, 392, 34 IPC and Section 25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Sujangarh, District Churu (Rajasthan). In that case, petitioner is facing trial and petitioner is on bail.</i>

It has also been brought to the notice of the Court that after the framing of charge, the Sessions Court has adjourned the case to 18.11.2022, for recording the testimony of the prosecution witnesses.

Hence, no ground to grant concession of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
