Allowed as prayed for. Annexure P-12 is taken on record.

Main case

The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of
the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of
mandamus; directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner
for appointment to the post of Temporary Peon against the vacant post.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Prateek Mahajan, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. It is pointed out by counsel for the respondents that in the process of selection involved in the present writ petition, the petitioner had not appeared for the interview. Therefore, there is no question of the petitioner being selected. Counsel has further submitted that there is no *mala fide* or biasness against the petitioner from the side of any body. This fact is further cleared from the fact that the real brother of the petitioner had appeared for the interview and had been selected and appointed in the same process of selection.

Counsel for the respondents has also produced a photocopy of the attendance list of the candidates, prepared at the time of interview. The same is taken on record. The aforesaid attendance list shows that the name of the petitioner does not find mention in the list of candidates, who appeared for the interview in the selection in question. There is no allegations of any *mala fide* against any person involved in the process of selection. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter.

Resultantly, the instant writ petition is dismissed.
