[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-3, dated 29.03.2022, in CWP No.6448 of 2022 in case titled as '**Naresh Kumar**versus**State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-3) reveals that CWP No.6448 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide pending representation dated 10.11.2021 within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 14.09.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 10.11.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 14.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
