As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellants, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.11,50,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakhs Fifty thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of both the appellants, who are present in person before this Forum, the enhanced amount would be paid to only appellant No.1-Ajinder Kaur.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.11,50,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakhs Fifty thousand only) in the name of the appellant No.1-Ajinder Kaur, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 27.10.2022 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The Office is directed to intimate the appellants about the cheque on mobile Nos. 9417039045 and 9417731507 as and when the cheque will be deposited before it by the Insurance Company.

Office of Lok Adalat to hand over the cheque to appellant No.2-Joginder Singh, as appellant No.1-Ajinder Kaur is not in position to travel due to her medical conditions

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
