[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 15.02.2021 in CRM-M No.7105 of 2021 in case titled as Bharat @ Gurbheg Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M No.7105 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into the grievance of the petitioners as contained in representation dated 01.07.2020 in case FIR No.50 dated 15.05.2020 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Phool, District Bathinda and take action in respect thereto as deemed appropriate, in accordance with law.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the needful having been done by the respondent qua the grievance of the petitioners as contained in representation dated 01.07.2020 in case

FIR No.50 dated 15.05.2020 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC

at Police Station Phool, District Bathinda, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
