Status report on behalf of respondent No.1-State {by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Adampur, District Jalandhar (Rural)}, has been submitted in the Court today and the same is taken on the record.

Learned State counsel points out that it has categorically been deposed in para No.9 in the said report that the investigation in the case is still pending and the Challan would be presented on the completion thereof.
