The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.95 dated 6.3.2019, registered under Section 307/34 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Old Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since in the petitioner's trial only 9 prosecution witnesses remain to be examined, at this stage, he does not press the present petition on its merits and would be satisfied if the same is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to conclude the petitioner's trial in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that she has no objection if the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

Since the petitioner is in custody for the last over 2 years; only 9 prosecution witnesses remain to be examined in his trial as also because 15 other criminal cases are pending against the petitioner, the above

alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted and the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to conclude the petitioner's trial within eight months from the next date fixed before it, in accordance with law.

It is clarified that the afore direction is subject to the cooperation by the petitioner / counsel appearing for him before the trial Court.
