By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.41, dated 26.11.2018, registered at Police Station GRP, Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 379-A, 411 and 34 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioner and respondents no.2 .

Pursuant to the order dated 01.10.2020, the report of the learned District and Sessions Judge, Karnal, dated 09.11.2020, has been received, stating therein that petitioner/accused Gulshan and complainant-Om Pal appeared before that Court and they got recorded their statements to the effect that the matter has been compromised between them.

Learned Sessions Judge, stated that he is satisfied with the compromise, which seems to be genuine and voluntary.

The accused Gulshan is stated to be facing trial in another case under Arms Act.

It has further been stated that the co-accused Ramphal has been declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 does not deny the factum of compromise reached between the parties.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.41, dated 26.11.2018, registered at Police Station GRP, Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 379-A, 411 and 34 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
