Petitioner/claimant is aggrieved against the decision dated 18.05.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh, whereby her application for release of pending amount of compensation of Rs.2,00,619/- was partly allowed by ordering release of only Rs.1,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/claimant has argued that on account of death of petitioner's husband, a total compensation of Rs.6,72,000/- was awarded to the claimants and the same was also enhanced to Rs. 9,75,520/- by this Court in their FAO No.2812 of 2003. He submits that the other claimants, who were minor at that time, have attained majority, but still the whole amount of compensation has not been released. He submits that out of remaining amount of Rs.2,00,619/-, the Tribunal has released only a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- to the claimant.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Varun Sharma, Advocate for Mr. Ashwani Talwar, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No.3 and states that he has no objection, if the whole amount is released to the claimant.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that the pending amount along with interest accrued thereupon, if any, be released to the claimant forthwith.
