The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing death certificate bearing registration No. D-2019:4-90006-010684 dated 09.11.2019, issued by the Sub Registrar (Birth and Death), PGI, Chandigarh (Annexure P-8) showing Surjivan Kaur, respondent No. 3, as the wife of deceased - Sukhdev Singh since it was obtained through deceitful manner by providing false and fabricated identification document and suppression of the material facts.

Perusal of the pleadings, as well as, the prayer made in the writ petition, in essence, shows that the petitioner has challenged the status of

respondent No. 3, as legally wedded wife of the deceased (Sukhdev Singh). The petitioner has alleged fraud on the part of respondent No. 3. The plea of fraud can be better agitated and proved before the civil Court. This Court is not supposed to take up the issue, involving the disputed question of facts.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail the remedy of civil suit, but in accordance with law.
