Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 and 2 to inquire into the allegations levelled in FIR No.239 dated 15.06.2022 lodged for offences under Sections 354, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 and 509 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Ram Nagar, Karnal, Annexure P-2, by some senior official and to look into her representation dated 15.07.2022, Annexure P-3.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent No.4 on 25.04.2021 and despite the fact that sufficient dowry, gold and silver articles were given, but respondent No.4 and his family members-respondents No.5 to 10, were not satisfied. He submits that they have been harassing and ill-treating the petitioner and turned out her from the matrimonial home.

Counsel states that she lodged FIR, Annexure P-2, which is not being inquired into and has submitted a representation, Annexure P-3, addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Karnal, respondent No.2. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the same.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the State.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on their behalf. As per instructions received by her from ASI Ashok Kumar, she submits that the delay occurred as the father of the complainant had informed the Investigating Officer that efforts are being made to get the matrimonial dispute compromised and settled.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the FIR or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-3, and take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
