Recalling of detailed order passed by a Brother Judge, who has recently demitted office, has been sought. It has been pointed out that neither the directions issued by this Court on 27.05.2022 were the subject matter of the dispute between the contesting parties in this revision petition nor all the effected parties were heard before passing of the order. As per the directions issued by the Court, the State Government was requested to take over the management of the religious property.

Learned Advocate General, Punjab, has entered appearance and submitted that he has no objection if the entire matter is reheard on merits.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this application falls within

the scope of procedural review in terms of judgment passed by the Supreme Court in Grindlays Bank Ltd. Vs. The Central Government Industrial Tribunal & ors., AIR 1981(Supreme court) 606 and Kapra Mazoor Ekta Union Vs. Management of M/s Birla cotton Sinning and Weaving Mills Ltd. And ors., 2005(3) A.I.R. (Supreme Court) 1782.

Consequently, the judgment dated 27.05.2020 is recalled. The revision petition is restored to its original number.
