As prayed for, the application is allowed.

Replication to the written statement filed on behalf of
respondents No. 1 to 3 is taken on record.

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Learned senior counsel for the petitioner argues that in the
present petition, the challenge was to the recording of adverse ACR for the
year 1995-96 and the other prayers made, were dependent upon the grant of
first prayer. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that during

the pendency of the writ petition, the respondents have passed an order on 22.07.2022 by which, the adverse remarks were recorded in the ACR for the year 1995-96, has been expunged, hence, now the petitioner is entitled for the grant of consequential relief of the same, which have been prayed by the petitioner in the present writ petition.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioner raises the grievance of the grant of consequential benefits, which according to the petitioner, he becomes entitled for after the passing of the order dated 22.07.2022 by filing appropriate representation, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks by the authority competent to do so.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
