Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in respect of FIR No. 62 dated 23.02.2019 registered under Sections 302, 386 and 34 of the IPC and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Badshahpur, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the present petition has been filed for the grant of regular bail but the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the trial Court to complete the trial within a period of six months so that the petitioner does not suffer

any prejudice.

Learned counsel for respondent-State raises no objection with regard to the grant of said prayer.
