This is a second petition seeking quashing of FIR No. 23 dated 28.2.2022, under Sections 419, 420, 120-B, 476, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh on the basis of compromise.

On 27th May, 2022, this Court passed the following order:-

not finding favour, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
