JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to constitute a Special Investigation Team (SIT) headed by a Police Officer not below the rank of Additional Director General of Police (ADGP) or transfer of investigation to CBI to conduct a fair, proper and impartial investigation in FIR No.35 dated 01.02.2020 registered under Sections 294, 504, 149 of the IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa (Annexure P-2), FIR No.57 dated 04.05.2020 registered under Section 188 of IPC, 1860 and Section 51 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala (Annexure P-7) and FIR No.170 dated 05.05.2020 registered under Section 51 of

Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur (Annexure P-8) .

At the very outset, the learned State counsel submits that a cancellation report has been prepared in FIR No.35 dated 01.02.2020 registered under Sections 294, 504, 149 of the IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa (Annexure P-2) but in any case respondent No.11 has since died and therefore, the proceedings in that FIR stand abated.

With respect to FIR No.57 dated 04.05.2020 registered under Section 188 of IPC, 1860 and Section 51 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala (Annexure P-7) and FIR No.170 dated 05.05.2020 registered under Section 51 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur (Annexure P-8), the learned State counsel submits that the respective reports under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. have been prepared and shall be submitted before the Court within a period of four weeks from today.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
