The Prayer in this petition is for the grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC in case FIR No.218 dated 18.04.2022 under Sections 341, 379-A, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Quilla Panipat.

The brief facts of the case are that a complaint was submitted by the complainant Khushi Ram who stated that while he was going from Chottu Ram Chowk, Panipat towards the drain on his motor cycle, a youth riding on a Splendor Motor cycle without a number plate intercepted, extended beatings to him and snatched his mobile phone along with Rs.500/- in cash. Based on the aforementioned allegations the present FIR came to be registered.

The Counsel for the petitioner at the very outset contends that a compromise has been effected between the parties pursuant to which a

petition bearing CRM-M-31931-2022 titled as Shanky Vs. State of Haryana & Anr. has been filed before this Court seeking quashing of aforesaid FIR based on such compromise. He thus prays for the grant of regular bail on this count.

The Counsel for the State on the other hand submits that the offence is serious in nature and the benefit of a compromise ought not be granted to the petitioner.

I have heard learned Counsel for both the parties at length.

A perusal of the order dated 27.07.2022 in CRM-M-31931-2022 titled as Shanky Vs. State of Haryana & Anr. shows that a compromise has been effected between the parties pursuant to which they have been ordered to get their statements recorded before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate 08.08.2022. Therefore, in view of the compromise the further incarceration of the petitioner is not required.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner **Shanky** son of Sh. Bal Krishan is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
