Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.40 dated 06.02.2022 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.08.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raghubir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 24.08.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on
