Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 02.05.2020 registered under Section 67-B of Information Technology Act, 2000, Sections, 12 and 18 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Morinda, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1).

Custody certificate dated 21.05.2022 has been filed, which is taken on record.

After having argued at some length, counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition. He, however, submits that as the petitioner is in custody since May, 2020, direction may be issued to the Trial Court to conclude the trial within a specific time frame.

Request of counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Considering the fact that FIR is of May, 2020 and 04 out of total 08 prosecution witnesses, have been examined, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the Trial Court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 04 months from today, provided that accused do not delay the conclusion of the trial.

Petition is disposed of.
