Prayer in the petition is for quashing of FIR No. 67 dated 06.04.2022, registered under Section 408 IPC, at Police Station City South, District Moga, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise deed/affidavit dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with the intervention of the respectable persons, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Notice of motion to respondent No. 1-State only, at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, AAG Punjab, accepts notice and on the instructions of SI Balwinder Singh, submits that the FIR was registered against the petitioner for committing fraud of Rs. 27,25,676/ with the Company and the anticipatory bail preferred by the petitioner was dismissed on 25.05.2022, but despite cancellation of the anticipatory bail, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

In view of the submission made by the learned State counsel, this Court does not find any ground for quashing of the FIR, therefore, the petition is dismissed.
