Learned counsel for the petitioner informs the Court that in pursuance to the order dated 29.07.2022 followed by the order dated 06.08.2022, petitioner has appeared before the Additional District and Sessions Judge-II, Jalandhar, and has furnished the surety bonds. On acceptance of the same, the petitioner has been released on interim bail.

Counsel for the State acknowledges the said fact on instructions from ASI Amrik Lal, Police Station Noor Mahal, Jalandhar.

In the light of the above, the petitioner is granted bail to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar.

It is made clear that this order of grant of bail has been passed in the peculiar circumstances of the present case and it would be open to the trial Court to again cancel the bail of the petitioner in case there is any default on his part during the trial proceedings.
