Instant Revision petition has been filed under Section 401, Cr.P.C., challenging order dated 10.01.2018 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, vide which application filed under Section 125, Cr.P.C., for grant of maintenance allowance, was partly allowed by awarding monthly maintenance of Rs.5,000/- to the wife (respondent No.1) and Rs.2500/- each to the two minor children (respondents No.2 and 3), from the date of the application.

On 24.05.2018, this Court passed the following order:-

*“Notice of motion be issued for 06.09.2018
subject to deposit of Rs.75,000/- with the Registry.*

*If the amount is deposited then there will be stay
with regard to maintenance amount beyond Rs.7500/-.”*

As per office note, the petitioner has not deposited the amount of Rs.75,000/- as directed by this Court, despite a lapse of more than 4 years.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner despite the fact that office has sent e-mail to the counsel for the petitioner informing him about the listing of the matter.

Petitioner was unrepresented even on the previous date.

It seems that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
