Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0031, dated 04.05.2022, under Section 22/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kabirpur, District Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 25.07.2022, notice of motion was issued and arrest of the petitioner was stayed as an interim measure and he was directed to join investigation within one week.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined investigation on 30.07.2022.

Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI Manjinder Singh, states that as of now petitioner is not required.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed and the order dated 25.07.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is
