Petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to take action on the complaint dated 20.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a 49 year old lady, who alongwith her daughter was threatened by the private respondents on 18.06.2022 and they forcibly entered her house. Counsel submits that despite a message having been sent by the petitioner's daughter on police helpline and representation dated 20.06.2022 (Annexure P-5), no action has been taken. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into representation (Annexure P-5).

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on their behalf.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to examine the representation dated 20.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) and to take suitable action thereon, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
