Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.12 dated 4.3.2022, registered under Sections 323, 376(2(n) and 506 IPC, at Women Police Station Fatehabad, District Fatehabad and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 18.7.2022 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the registration of the FIR, the petitioner and the prosecutrix are married and they are living together. He also submits that before the trial Court the prosecutrix has already appeared as prosecution witness and she has not supported the case of the prosecution.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 also affirmed the aforesaid fact.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that out of 21 prosecution witnesses, 10 witnesses have already been examined and now the case is fixed before the trial Court for 1.8.2022.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner candidly submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue the remedy as available to the petitioner before the trial Court.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. In the peculiar facts and circumstances, the learned trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same expeditiously.
