Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to finalize the door-to-door survey for exclusion of certain area of Gram Panchayat, Village Chattar Patti, Tehsil and District Sirsa, without any delay.

Short reply, by way of affidavit of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Sirsa, District Sirsa, on behalf of respondent No.6, has been filed in Court. Same is taken on record.

Precise grievance of the petitioner is that after transferring some area of his village to Municipal limits of Sirsa, population of that area be excluded from the Panchayat election, which is due to be held.

As per reply filed by respondent No.6, it has been clarified that out of the total population of 2214 pertaining to Gram Panchayat, Chattargarh Patti, population of 1962 has been included in the municipal limits of Sirsa as per census of 2011. After inclusion, population of village Chattargarh Patti recuded to 252 only. This population is likely to be

included in nearby village and a proposal has been sent by the Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa, for taking necessary action in the matter. Along with the reply, respondents have placed on record copy of letter dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure R-1), whereby a proposal has been sent to include the remaining population of Gram Panchayat, Chattargarh in the Gram Panchayat of village Channu Shahid, which is existing near this village.

Keeping in view the letter dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure R-1), no directions are required to be given in this petition, as remaining population of village Chattargarh Patti is to be included in nearby village.

Disposed of accordingly.
