The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed seeking issuance of directions/orders to the official respondents to consider grievance espoused by the petitioners in the complaint dated 25.07.2020 (Annexure P-12) pertaining to the injuries caused to the petitioners by the private respondents.

Pursuant to the order dated 30.09.2020 passed by this Court, status report by way of affidavit of Dharam Paul, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Ludhiana, on behalf of the respondent-State, has been filed. A relevant extract therefrom reads thus:-

“5. That on 16.12.2020, petitioner no.2 had made a statement with the police levelling allegations that on 31.03.2020, the complainant and his father Rakesh Sood caused injuries to petitioner no.2. In the MLR of petitioner no.2, two injuries with sharp edged weapon have been mentioned and therefore Cross-Case u/s 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC

vide DDR No.26 dated 16.12.2020 has been registered against the complainant Amit Sood and his father Rakesh Sood in the above noted FIR No.157 dated 1-6-2020 u/s 323, 324, 506, 427, 34 IPC increased u/s 379B IPC PS Salem Tabri Ludhiana and further investigation is being conducted in the said Cross-Case also and after completion of the same, Challan/Final Report un/s 173 Cr.P.C. will be prepared accordingly. However, earlier petitioner no.1 had moved complaint dated 25.07.2020 levelling allegations that respondents no.5 and 6 have Caused injury to petitioner no.2 and also spoken defamatory language against the caste of petitioners. Enquiry on the said application of petitioner no.1 was conducted by the SHO, P.S. Salem Tabri, Ludhiana during which it was revealed that regarding causing injury to petitioner no.2 the above noted cross case has already been registered but no defamatory language was spoken about the caste of the petitioners there for the said complainant of petitioner no.1 has been consigned to the office record these allegations of the petitioners were found to be false.”

It has been apprised by the learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harmesh Lal, that pursuant to the cross case, the assailants have also been arrested.

In view of the aforesaid status report and the statement made a part today, no cause of action survives for consideration in the present petition. The same is dismissed as not pressed.
