As per the office report, notice sent to respondent No.1, 3, 4 and 5, have been received back served, whereas, respondent No.2 is reported to be out of country. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that respondent No.2 is not the contesting respondent. Pursuant to the orders passed by the Commercial Court, the trial of the Civil Suit has been assigned to the Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division, Ludhiana. The petitioner claims that the case should be tried at Samrala, which is the Sub-Division of the Ludhiana District Court. The learned counsel representing the petitioner does not dispute that the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Ludhiana, has the territorial jurisdiction to decide the suit.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
