AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and also directing them not to interfere in the personal life of the petitioner.

On 16.8.2022, learned counsel appeared on behalf of respondent even though notice had not been issued. He had submitted that he had produced in Court two orders passed in CRWP-5641-2022 purportedly filed by the petitioner -Rekha Rani. He had contended that for the same relief as prayed for in this petition, she had filed the aforesaid CRWP and even though, she had withdrawn the same but no liberty was granted to file a fresh one on the same cause of action. However, without mentioning the fact of filing of the previous petition, the present petition has been filed.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 16.8.2022, the Coordinate Bench has observed that it is made clear that if the counsel for the petitioner does not appear on the adjourned date i.e. today, this petition shall stand dismissed.

Keeping in view of the fact that none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner despite the matter being called twice today and also in view of the observations made in the previous order dated 16.8.2022, the present petition stands dismissed.
