The petitioner seeks a direction to respondent No.2 to hold a fair and independent enquiry, on the complaint of the petitioner against the private respondents No.5 to 11 and to provide protection to her and her family members.

The present litigation has arisen out of FIR No.26 dated 10.02.2020 under Sections 363/366/376/34 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar on the statement of one Balwinder Kaur – respondent No.5, mother of the girl against Jagdish Singh.

Status report has been filed by SSP, Jalandhar (Rural) dated 22.09.2022, in compliance to the order dated 28.07.2022, which is taken on record. A perusal of the aforesaid status report specifically suggests that the allegations levelled in the complaint have been found to be false. It has also transpired that girl namely, Karamjit Kaur became major and on 21.07.2022

she has got married to one Sukhwinder Singh s/o Gurmez Singh, r/o Sanghe Khalsa, Police Station Nurmahal.

In view of the submissions made and the stand taken by the official respondents in the status report, the present petition has been rendered infructuous, as no grievance is now left out to be adjudicated by this Court.
