SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

As prayed for, learned counsel for the petitioners he is permitted to withdraw the instant revision petition, directed against the order dated 09.04.2021, passed by the learned JMIC, Talwandi Sabo, where through, charges became framed against the present petitioners, for offences under Sections 447, 434 of IPC, and, *qua* an offence under Section 13-A(a) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961. Though *prima facie* the incrimination drawn against the present petitioners, becomes rested, and, dependent, upon a report of the Demarcating Officer concerned, who in his report declared, that the present petitioners had encroached upon the panchayat land, which is adjacent to their land, which they acquired, through a validly executed deed of conveyance. Nonetheless, the report of the Demarcating Officer has been affirmed by the Collector, District Bathinda, and, also by the Commissioner, Faridkot Division, Faridkot. However, the above orders have not been challenged by the petitioners, through their casting a revision petition, before the learned Financial Commissioner

(Revenue) to the Govt. of Punjab.

Consequently, liberty is reserved to the petitioners to make a challenge to the above concurrently made orders by the Collector, District Bathinda, and, by the Commissioner, Faridkot Division, Faridkot, through theirs preferring a revision petition, under, the relevant provisions of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, before the Financial Commissioner (Revenue), to the Govt. of Punjab.

The above be done forthwith, and, upon its preferment, before the learned Financial Commissioner (Revenue) to the Govt. of Punjab, the latter shall make a prompt decision thereon, and, awaiting a decision thereon, by the learned Financial Commissioner (Revenue) to the Govt. of Punjab, the learned trial Court may not draw any further action *qua* the petitioners.
