The present petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit of child care leave for a period of 177 days, which according to the petitioner was not being extended by the respondents despite the fact that the petitioner was eligible for the grant of the same.

Learned State counsel submits that vide interim order dated 05.07.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the benefit of availing child care leave has been extended in favour of the petitioner but, the petitioner did not avail the said benefit.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner that in case she intends to avail child care leave in future, she can apply for the same and the

respondents be directed to decide the said request of the petitioner for the grant of child care leave expeditiously in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any request for the grant of child care leave is received from the petitioner in future, an appropriate order on the same will be passed expeditiously in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
