Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view paragraph 2 of the reply filed, no grievance of the petitioners except petitioner No. 6 subsists. Learned counsel submits that though the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further but liberty be given to petitioner No.6 and to the other petitioners as well that in case any of their benefit, as submitted by the respondents in Paragraph 4 of their reply has not been extended to them, to approach the respondents for the redressal of their grievance by filing appropriate representation.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners raising any grievance, the same will be addressed in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that in case any of the grievance subsists even after approaching the Government, the petitioners will be at liberty to agitate their claim before the appropriate authority.
