Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Sidhu, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

On a request made by the State counsel, vide order dated 08.09.2021, the petitioner was directed to re-join the investigation and co-operate with the Investigating Agency.

Upon instructions from SI Manoj Kumar, State counsel submits that the petitioner has re-joined the investigation, recovery has been effected from him and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
