The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to issue Police Clearance Certificate enabling the petitioner to go abroad.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Gagandeep Singh, has apprised the Court that the petitioner has already been granted VISA and he has already gone abroad. Hence, the present petition has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has no instructions in this regard.

Taking into consideration the statement made by the learned State Counsel, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case the statement made by the learned State Counsel is found to be false or incorrect.
