Admittedly the marriage between the parties is about 18 years old and two children have born out of the wedlock, who are studying in the care and custody of the respondent-wife and an FIR under Sections 323, 34, 498-A, 406 IPC is also pending at Karnal and the respondent-wife has filed the present petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which shows she is still interested to live with the petitioner-husband.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, finding that the Court is not inclined to grant any relief in view of the aforesaid facts, seeks withdrawal of the present petition.
